Dr. MGR-Janaki College was established in 1996 by Dr. Latha Rajendran as a tribute to the late Bharat Ratna Dr. M.G. Ramachandran, former Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu, and his esteemed wife, Mrs. Janaki Ramachandran. Guided by the visionary leadership of its Founder, the institution has evolved from modest beginnings into a premier centre of higher education, consistently producing academic rank holders across diverse disciplines.

The College commenced its journey with 70 students and 16 faculty members and has since grown exponentially. Today, it caters to over 4,000 students, offering 11 undergraduate programmes and 2 postgraduate programmes.

It also proudly offers unique courses such as B.A. Performing Arts (Digital Media Integration) and M.A. Performing Arts, an interdisciplinary programme encompassing dance, music, theatre, yoga, history, and philosophy-distinctive as the only programme of its kind in Tamil Nadu.

At present, Dr. MGR–Janaki College functions as the Adyar campus of VISTAS (Vels Institute of Science, Technology & Advanced Studies), a Deemed-to-be University recognized as a Category I institution by the UGC and Accredited by NAAC with A++ . It is part of a vast educational network comprising 52 institutions across 34 campuses, with over 7,700 staff members and a vibrant student community exceeding 51,000 learners.

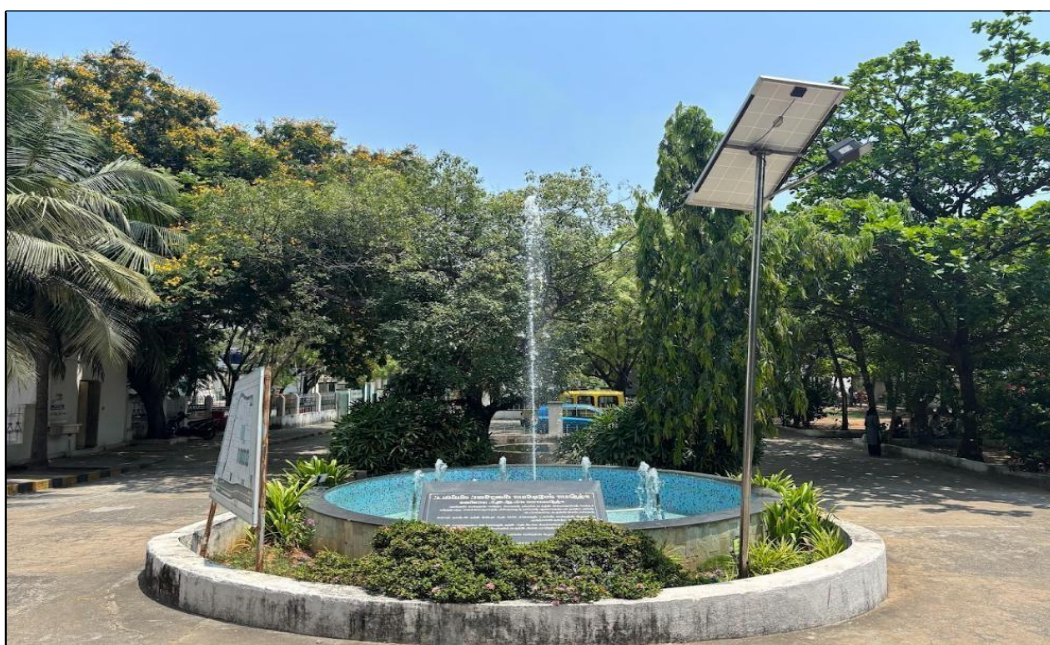

LOCATION AND INFRASTRUCTURAL FACILITIES

CAMPUS

The college is strategically located in the heart of Chennai, at Raja Annamalai Puram, near Adyar. The centrally situated campus is set amidst well-maintained, serene gardens that create a calm and inspiring learning environment. It is well connected to all parts of the city through numerous bus routes, with easy access from the “Sathya Studios” bus stop. The campus enjoys close proximity to several renowned institutions, including the Indian Institute of Technology, Central Leather Research Institute, Anna University, MGM Healthcare (formerly known as Fortis Malar Hospital), Kalakshetra, PGIBMS, Tamil Nadu Music and Fine Arts University, the Cancer Institute, The Voluntary Health Services, the Theosophical Society, M.S. Swaminathan Research Foundation, and Andhra Mahila Sabha. Additionally, essential facilities such as shops, post offices, and banks are conveniently located within walking distance, ensuring ease and accessibility for students.

LIBRARY

The library is well stocked and housed in a spacious hall with extensive reading materials. It has a total collection of approximately 34,985 books and provides access to more than 100 journals and magazines. E-library facilities, including INFLIBNET and DELNET, offer access to a wide range of online resources. Each department also maintains its own departmental library. Photocopying facilities are available for the benefit of both students and faculty. The college holds institutional membership with the British Council Library.

COMPUTER CENTER

The college provides a highly sophisticated computer center equipped with 300 + computers, offering students excellent hands-on experience with the latest machines, software, and tools. The college also has well-equipped Microprocessor and Digital Laboratories.

LABORATORY

The college has well-equipped laboratories for Computer Science, Bioinformatics, and Psychology. A Digital Language Laboratory is also available.

Regular academic coaching is complemented by guest lectures delivered by experts, providing students with broader exposure. Field trips and visits to research centers and institutions are organized regularly to enhance experiential learning.

The institution offers ample opportunities for co-curricular and extracurricular activities, including music, dance, yoga, aerobics, and karate, conducted after class hours. Additionally, short-term value-added certificate courses are made available to all students.

ADMISSION – PROCEDURE

Students are required to register along with the completed application forms. After registration, communication will be sent to those students who have been provisionally selected. All admission is provisional, subject to approval by VISTAS (Vels Institute of Science, Technology & Advanced Studies). The decision of the Admission Committee will be final in all matters concerning admission.

The following certificates should be produced in original at the time of admission:

1. The Tamil Nadu Higher Secondary course (or its equivalent) Mark certificate (original + 2 photocopies attested by a Gazetted officer) for UG Courses and Provisional Certificate or Degree certificate for PG Courses.
2. Copy of Aadhar Card
3. Original Transfer Certificate
4. Copy of Community Certificate
5. Medical Certificate from a Government Registered Medical Practitioner.
6. Community Certificate (one photocopy attested by a Gazetted officer) if the student belongs to BC/MBC/SC/ST.

PAYMENT OF FEES

If the provisional selection is confirmed, the candidate should be prepared to pay the fees immediately. Generally, a student once admitted to a course will not be permitted to withdraw. However, under unavoidable circumstances, withdrawal may be allowed provided the student pays the fees for the whole academic year. Fees once paid is not refundable under any circumstance.

NOTE FOR PARENTS

Parents are requested to cooperate with the college authorities in enforcing punctuality & regularity in attendance. Other than regular tests we hold examinations in September and March. We report the marks and statement of attendance after each of these examinations. Parents are expected to come in person for the Open Day to receive the mark statement and meet the teachers, who would like to discuss with them the progress of their wards. Parents who wish to meet the teachers on other days must enquire and wait at the Principal's office only. Warning letters are sent to the parents if their wards are irregular to college.

SPECIAL NOTE TO STUDENTS

- Students are required to maintain a neat, simple, and modest dress code at all times within the campus. Attire that is short, tight, or revealing is strictly prohibited.
- Ragging in any form is strictly forbidden. The institution adopts a zero-tolerance policy, and any student found involved will face severe disciplinary action as per regulations.
- Students commuting on two-wheelers must compulsorily wear helmets to ensure personal safety.
- The use of mobile phones within the campus is not permitted, unless specifically authorized.
- Students shall not participate in fashion shows, modeling assignments, television programs, or similar public activities without obtaining prior permission from the Management or the Principal.
- All students are expected to uphold high standards of conduct and character, demonstrating honesty, respect for elders, and kindness towards all.
- The Management and authorized authorities may frame and enforce rules, temporary or permanent, to regulate student conduct and uphold the institution's discipline and reputation.

ATTENDANCE

- Regular attendance in both classroom and laboratory sessions, along with timely completion of assignments, is mandatory for all students.
- Attendance is recorded for every lecture, practical, and tutorial as per the college timetable, including activities such as Games, NSS, and Eye Opener programmes.
- Leave of absence may be granted subject to valid justification.
- Absence due to illness must be supported by a medical certificate from a registered medical practitioner.
- Students representing the college in extracurricular activities must submit permission letters to the principal through the authorized staff member.
- Leave letters for other purposes must be approved by the class teacher.
- Students granted On Duty (OD) will have their attendance marked as “C,” indicating that they are credited with attendance even though they are not physically present in class (e.g., representing the college at events).
- Students arriving after the Assembly will be marked absent for one hour. Absence for one hour will result in the loss of half a day’s attendance.
- A student will be permitted to appear for University Examinations only if she meets the minimum requirement of 75% attendance in each course.
- The decision of the Management/Principal shall be final in all matters related to attendance.

IDENTITY CARDS

Each student of this college is expected to possess an Identity Card with her photograph affixed on it, duly attested by the principal. Students are advised to keep the card with them always and use them for getting concessional ticket to travel by bus, rail or air, to become a member of Public Libraries or for the receipt of payment of scholarship, etc. Identity cards for the first year students will be provided in the college. Students will have to produce the ID card during the University Examinations.

EXAMINATIONS

- No student shall absent herself from any examination without prior permission of the Principal.
- Disciplinary action will be taken against absentees from examinations and tests.
- All assignments and practical records / books should be submitted on time.
- Punctuality in attendance and work is important.
- The conduct of the students during the test and examinations should be beyond reproach.
- Any student indulging in unfair practices or caught copying, will be dealt with seriously.
- Assessment will be in the form of a comprehensive examination of each paper at the end of each semester.

- University examinations will be conducted at the end of each semester in the college.
- Students should register for the examinations paying the prescribed fees.
- Using Mobile phones inside the college campus is prohibited.

ALUMNAE

The Alumnae Association of Dr. MGR–Janaki College was established in 1999, three years after the inception of the institution. Its objective is to sustain the bond between the alumnae and the college by preserving shared memories, ideals, and values, while maintaining a strong connection with graduates across the globe. Final-year students are formally inducted into the Alumnae Association at the end of the academic year, typically in March. The Alumnae Meet is held annually on the last Sunday of November.
